

# SILVERSTREAM



## PERTAINING TO STAGES 5 - 11 OF SILVERSTREAM SUBDIVISION, KAIAPOI

#### 1. The Building and/or site shall not:

- 1.1 Erect fences on the boundaries of the developed property other than in accordance with the Developer Approval of the plans and specifications and the provisions of the Fencing Act 1978.
- 1.2 Erect fences otherwise in accordance with the provisions of the Waimakariri District Plan and in particular the rules relating to all fencing between residential properties and reserve land.


#### 2. The Building and/or site shall ensure:

- 2.1 Any fence facing a road boundary shall incorporate design features and be constructed from quality materials approved by the Developer.
- 2.2 Any fence constructed on a road boundary shall not exceed 1.2 metres in height and must have 45% transparency, with the exception of a corner site as outlined in (6) below. Refer to illustrated site diagram (309).
- 2.3 Any fence facing a road boundary that exceeds 1.2 metres in height, must have 45% transparency and be set back 2 metres, not exceeding a maximum height of 1.8 metres. This fence is not to cover any part of the house facade, unless expressly approved by the Developer. Refer to illustrated site diagram (308).
- 2.4 On a corner site only should they choose and as approved by the Developer, erect a 1.8 metre fence with 45% transparency at 0.5 metres back from the road boundary, preference is that this fence incorporates a minimum of one insert, 0.5 metres in depth and 1.5 metres in length. This insert is to be positioned at midpoint in the fence and must incorporate a feature tree and additional planting no less than 0.6 metres in height within the insert as well as along the fence facing the street. Refer to illustrated site diagram (307).
- 2.5 All side and rear fences are not to exceed 1.8 metres in height and will end at least 2 metres back from the road boundary, unless a front fence of 1.2 metres is erected on a road boundary as outlined in (4) and diagram (309). In this instance, the side boundary fence is to taper from the end point 2 metres back, down to 1.2 metres, meeting the height of the front fence.




- 2.6 All side and rear boundary fencing is to be constructed as follows:
  - Paling fences are to be double overlap including capping
  - Concrete must be used and with a solid footing of concrete to the posts
  - Capping is to be mitred with a tidy join
  - Number 1 grade timber must be used in all materials of fencing construction
  - 125/75 posts with a depth of at least 750mm in the ground
  - 75/50 number 1 grade fencing rails
  - Ex 100/50 peaked capping
  - Premium grade 12mm palings
  - Galvanised nails must be used
- 2.7 Any fencing that is adjacent to a reserve must be constructed with black aluminum pool type fencing at a height of 1.2 metres, as approved by the Developer.


